Times: Arrival by lunchtime on Saturday
22nd July and leaving around 14.30 on Tuesday
25th July 2017. Times will be confirmed with you
by DELTA's summer school family coordinator
who will be in touch within 2 weeks of receiving a
postal application, quicker if using email.

Where is it held: The accommodation is within
the Cardiff Metropolitan University Campus. Work-
shops and crèche facilities are at a school close
by. A mini bus will be available for transfers for
those who do not have cars.

Accommodation is self-catering in flats with
integral kitchen and lounge and bedrooms each
with en-suite. They are fully equipped with bed
linen & are clean and comfortable, though basic.
We suggest you bring your own towels and
washing materials. Please note children will need
packed lunches.

How much will it cost: The summer school
costs DELTA almost £1000 per family but we ask
for a minimum contribution of £150 per family
based on two adults and their children. Additional
family and friends are welcome, but there is a
supplement of £50 per person. We ask for £50
deposit when posting your application, as we have
to pay for the flats considerably in advance.

DELTA Summer Schools provide advice, support and encouragement to families who want their deaf children to learn to listen and talk.

The children and young people are looked after by teams of qualified and experienced volunteers.

The youngest can have fun in a well-equipped crèche whilst the older ones join in activity groups of their own age and interest.



What is covered? Parents take part in informal discussion groups and workshops, led by experienced lecturers, parents, audiologists and teachers. Typical topics, will include:

- Advising on everyday maintenance of hearing aids, cochlear implants and radio aids
- Supporting listening, language & literacy in the home & the school
- Facilitating access to whole school curriculum
- Making the most of the support available to you

The atmosphere is friendly, welcoming and informal. There is time to talk with other families and volunteers, many of whom are young adults who are deaf or parents and siblings of children and young people who are deaf.



There are always opportunities to speak with qualified volunteers about specific concerns.

Why should I attend? Because DELTA is the only charity helping your deaf child to listen and talk as one of the family through the Natural Aural Approach.
