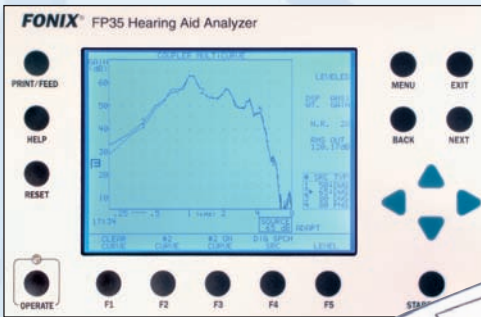




# KEEP CALM AND TESTBOX ON

## In 2013 using a testbox is more relevant than ever for teachers of the deaf and educational audiologists

- Children now have the latest, sophisticated digital hearing aids but are they working as they should?
- A testbox will identify simple problems that can make a huge difference. If the test curve has changed from last time, perhaps a microphone cover is blocked?
- You can ensure that fm systems are set-up correctly to work with particular hearing instruments, so that children hear the correct sounds at the correct level
- You will be confident that you are supporting children in line with current best practice guidelines and quality standards
