Qualified Teacher of Learning & Skills (QTLS)

Society for Education & Learning (SET)

As at 19.3.22.

To apply for QTLS status **you need to be a SET member** and meet the following criteria:

- hold an eligible teaching qualification at Level 5 or above *
- hold an eligible Level 2 maths and English qualifications, Level 3 if you teach discrete maths or English
- be teaching or training in a further education and skill setting for a minimum of four hours a week throughout the QTLS programme
- have identified a suitable supporter.

Cost £490, process take about 6 months

There are two registration windows:

- 1 September 30 September 2022, with portfolios issued in early October.
- 1 December 2022 06 January 2023, with portfolios issued in early January.

If working in Schools

Professional Formation, leading to QTLS is designed for teachers and trainers working in the Further Education and Training sector and as such participants should have regular access to teaching in this sector. If you currently work in a school, particularly where the learners you teach are below sixth form, you should consider undertaking QTS.

If hold PGCE & QTS

You must meet one of the following criteria:

- Trained as a teacher to work in schools and have a PGCE with QTS and currently be working in the FE and training sector
- Trained as a teacher to work in secondary schools and currently be working in the FE and skills sector
- Trained as a teacher to work in primary schools and currently be working in the FE and skills sector.

You must hold one of the following for Level 5:

- Diploma in Education and Training (DET)
- Diploma in Teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector (DTLLS)
- Teachers or trainers with DET or PGCE (FE)

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 An equivalent qualification on our <u>approved list</u> working in a range of other settings - this must include 100 hours of teaching and eight observations of your teaching practice.

Other approved qualifications

You must have been awarded and certificated for a Teacher Education qualification that is equivalent to Diploma in Education and Training (DET) before registering for Professional Formation leading to QTLS or Advanced Teacher Status (ATS).

QTLS and ATS participants will need a minimum Level 5 qualification with a credit value of 120 that includes a practical teaching component requiring the logging of 100 hours of teaching and eight observations of your teaching.

The following are accepted by SET as qualifications equivalent to a DET, but please note that this list is not exhaustive.
