Positive Looking Awareness

(3 hour/half day)

During this half day course, you will be learn about the educational implications for learners with vision impairment, understand visual skill development and how to provide an appropriate learning environment.

Positive Looking Practitioner Course

(6 hour/full day)


In addition to the topics above, the full day course will cover how to select and employ appropriate strategies to support the learner's visual skill development within the curriculum. You will also cover observing, assessing responses and planning for targeted intervention to develop with visual skills guidance/advice from QTVI. Practitioners taking this course will have the option to complete a course book of activities (approx. 10 hours work.) The course is assessed and a Certificate of Recognition is presented on successfully passing the course. (Please note this is not a formal qualification.)
