Investigating mental fatigue in children with sensory loss in educational settings

What is the study about?

We are interested in whether children with sensory loss experience mental fatigue as a result of the interaction between the classroom environment and their sensory loss.

What can I expect?

Parents, teachers and pupils will be asked to complete a few short online questionnaires. Teachers can assist children in filling out their questionnaires if necessary. The questionnaires will take **up to 30 minutes** to complete. Teachers will receive a **£15 Amazon voucher** for each child that they recruit. Parents will also receive a £15

Amazon voucher for participation.

Who are we looking to recruit?

- Pupils in years 4-6, aged 9 to 11.5 with sensory loss (i.e. visual and/or hearing impairments), attending a mainstream primary school and with no additional learning needs
- A peer from the same class without sensory loss
- Teachers and parents of the children

How will my data be used?

Once collected, your data will be **pseudo-anonymous**. This means that identifiable information will be removed from the data and a code will be assigned.

We are hoping to use the data that we collect to learn more about the challenges that children with sensory loss face, and possibly to inform future educational policy changes.
